Advance tickets are \$15 general admission and \$12 seniors and students. At the door, tickets are \$18 and \$15. No one is turned away due to lack of funds.

Covid-19 requirements will be followed. All concert attendees must wear masks and show proof of full vaccination. Chorus members will wear special singers' masks. Seating will be distanced and limited. Reservations or early arrival at the venue is recommended.
